A conference call was held on March 7, 2017 to discuss a request to fund costume rentals for the upcoming spring musical, The Little Mermaid. Since the play is just a few weeks away, a conference call was held to expedite this request.

Marsha Minge:

The Spring Musical, the Little Mermaid, is scheduled on 3/31 – 4/1. Mrs. Minge is asking MMAC to provide funds for costume rentals, which will be between \$1200 to \$2000. This show is more costume heavy than ones performed in the past and rental costumes are needed. The rentals will be kept to a minimum and existing costumes at MHS will be utilized wherever possible. MMAC will be reimbursed with any profits that remain after the rights to the show are covered.

An idea to offset this cost will be to see if Kohl's Cares volunteers could be used to assist one evening to help complete sets and painting. Mrs. Minge will provide Kindra Davis with dates the volunteers could be used and Kindra will work with Kohl's to see if we can get 5 volunteers to help for 3 hours one afternoon. This would amount to a \$500 donation towards this expense.

Maryanne Ferrell made a motion to approve the necessary funds up to \$2000 with the stipulation MMAC be reimbursed out of any profits and an attempt to get Kohl's volunteers is made. Tammy Berkhouse seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
